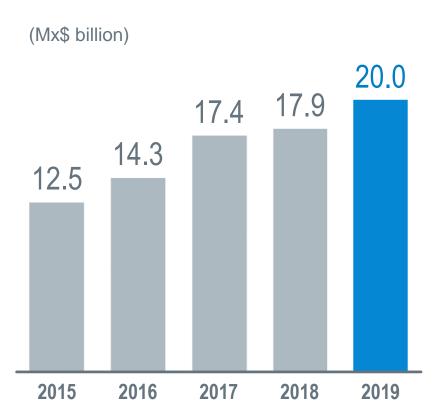

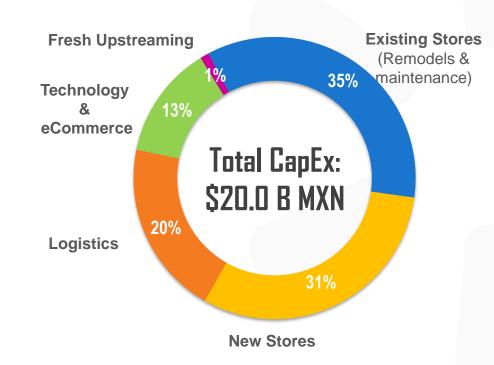
Balance sheet statement (September 30th 2019 – MX\$ Million)

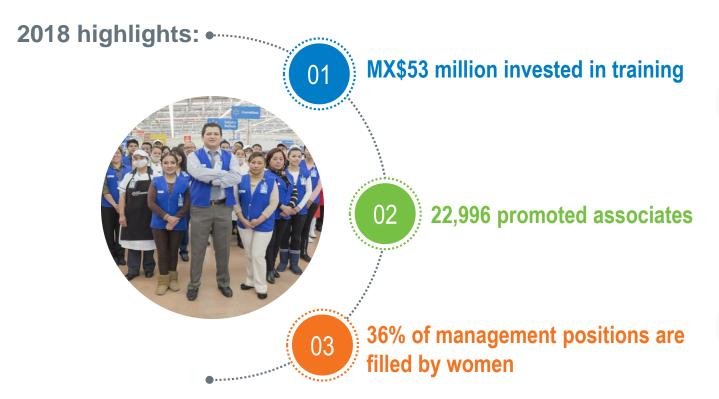
